Media Release

This afternoon (4/12/24) Jarrell Childs, 19, of Detroit, was arraigned at 14A-1 District Court on charges of criminal sexual conduct – first degree, assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder or by strangulation, stealing a financial transaction device without consent, and larceny. The charges stem from a sexual assault that occurred on 11/4/23 on the Ann Arbor Golf and Outing Club located at 400 E. Stadium.

It is alleged Childs, and a 13-year-old male sexually assaulted a 39-year-old female as she was walking back to her vehicle, which was parked on the golf course. Childs and the 13-year-old male did not know the victim prior to this incident, and this was a random attack. The sexual assault occurred while the University of Michigan football game against Purdue was taking place at Michigan Stadium.

Childs was given a bond of \$75,000 cash/surety, no 10%. He remains lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail.

A juvenile petition was authorized against the 13-year-old male for criminal sexual conduct – first degree, assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder or by strangulation, larceny from the person, and stealing a financial transaction device without consent. He is currently lodged at the Washtenaw County Juvenile Detention Center.
