Community members like you are eligible to apply for the following awards, ranging from \$1000-\$4,000.

<u>AIR Gives Opportunity Scholarship:</u> This scholarship is designed to assist college freshmen or returning undergraduates.

<u>Bill Gandert Memorial Vocational Scholarship</u>: This scholarship program is directed to graduating high school seniors interested in studying a specific trade (electrician, nurse, plumber, medical assistant, hair stylist, paramedic, etc.)

<u>Mary Lou Manzie Memorial Scholarship</u>: Assistance will be provided to benefit nontraditional students (students who have been out of high school for at least three years) in pursuing an associates or undergraduate degree.

<u>Neil Churchill Memorial Scholarship:</u> Assistance is provided to those eligible applicants who are seeking to complete graduate level coursework.
