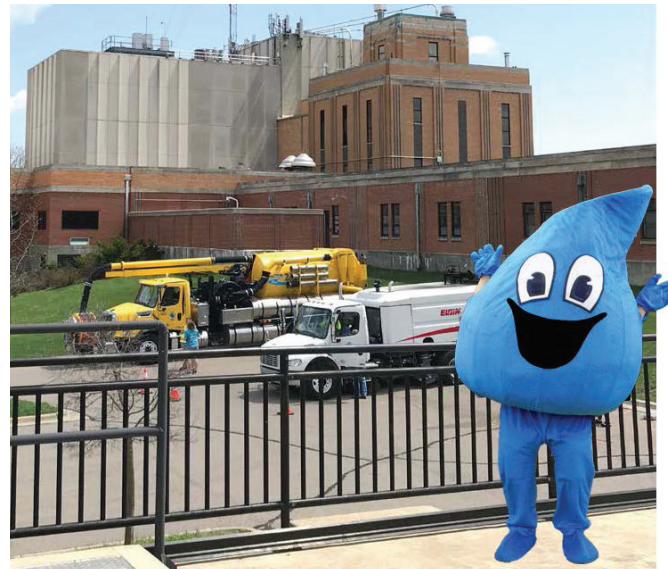


CELEBRATE NATIONAL DRINKING WATER WEEK
