CITY ATTORNEY SEARCH STATUS REPORT**

CITY ATTORNEY SEARCH UPDATE

Human Resources Director Thomas White presented a status report on the city attorney search. As of this date, the Human Resources Department has only received 10 applications. The ads were run in 6 state-wide and 1 national publication. Tom suggested to run ads in the state-wide publication for at least one more week and extend the application period.

A discussion by the Council ensued. Options discussed by the Council were: employment of a recruitment firm, formatting a city profile similar to the City Administrator candidate profile.

It was a consensus of the Council that the Human Resources Department pursue the issues discussed here this date and the Council meet in a working session on June 12, 1995 for further discussion.
