

**ANN ARBOR CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
WORKING SESSION - NOVEMBER 13, 2006**

Mayor Pro-Tem Easthope called the working session of the Ann Arbor City Council to order at 7:10 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chamber, 100 N. Fifth Avenue, Ann Arbor.

WORK SESSION

UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN FORD NUCLEAR REACTOR DISCHARGE OF POOL WATER TO SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM

Jim Kosteva, Vice President of Governmental Relations for the University of Michigan, and other University officials presented information to Council regarding the ongoing decommissioning of the North Campus reactor that had been in operation since 1957. University officials discussed the radioactivity level of the 50,000 gallon reactor pool versus other common sources of radioactivity, including chest x-rays and CT Scan.

REVIEW FUNDING FOR THE PROPOSED LIBRARY AND GUY C. LARCOM SITES FOR 15TH DISTRICT COURT AND POLICE SERVICES

Kenneth Clein, Architect for Quinn Evans, presented models for the Larcom site and the Library lot, including a Police and Court addition and a future City Hall development.

Tom Crawford, CFO, explained various financial scenarios and funding solutions for both the Library lot scenario and the two different expansions of the existing Larcom site. Mr. Crawford provided slides demonstrating the current conditions of the Police facilities within City Hall.

Chief Barnett Jones, Safety Services Administrator, explained the current constraints on the Police Department related to the existing facilities, including security concerns and space issues.

Mr. Crawford presented information related to the City's current costs for leased office space, including the existing Court space located at the Washtenaw County Courthouse.

Mayor Pro-Tem Easthope reminded Council and the public that a public hearing would be held on Monday, November 27, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
