CITY CLERK'S OFFICE CLOSED ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16 Closing necessary for office relocation to Larcom City Hall

ANN ARBOR, Mich. –March 11, 2011 – On Wednesday, March 16, 2011, the City of Ann Arbor Clerk's Office will be closed to the public as it relocates from the City Center Building back to the second floor at Larcom City Hall. The City Clerk's Office had been operating from the City Center building since January while City Hall second floor renovations were completed.

In addition, due to renovations on the second floor at Larcom City Hall, all City Council, Board and Commission meetings had been relocated offsite through March. Any meetings televised on Community Television Network will continue to air live or be taped for later replay. These meetings also will be available for replay on video on demand at www.a2gov.org/ctn.
