

**ANN ARBOR CITY NOTICE**

**ORDINANCE NO. ORD-10-36  
SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL**

Section 7.4 of the Ann Arbor City Charter authorizes the publication by summary of ordinances over 500 words in length.

The following is a summary of Ordinance No. ORD-10-36:

Ordinance No. ORD-10-36 amends the existing Chapter 63 of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor to require, effective March 1, 2011, control of stormwater runoff from the “first flush” storm event from the added impervious area on single and two-family residential property when adding 200 square feet or more of impervious area to the property. Ordinance No. ORD-10-36 also amends the existing Chapter 63 to update and clarify some terms.

The ordinance will take effect on the tenth day following legal publication.

The complete text of this ordinance is available for inspection at the Ann Arbor City Clerk’s Office on the 2nd floor of the Guy C. Larcom Municipal Building, 100 N. Fifth Ave, Ann Arbor.
