ORDINANCE NO. ORD-10-14
STREETS
ESTABLISH SIDEWALK OCCUPANCY STANDARDS FOR PORTABLE
OFF-PREMISE SIGNS IN THE DOWNTOWN

The following is a summary of Ordinance No. ORD-10-14:

Ordinance No. ORD-10-14 amends Section 4:14, Street and Sidewalk Occupancy Permits, of Chapter 47 (Streets). The amendments to Section 4:14 establish sidewalk occupancy standards and permit requirements for portable off-premise signs in the downtown.
