Residential Parking Permits will only be issued TO APPLICANTS LIVING IN THE AFFECTED AREA. You must show proof that residency has been established by providing a copy of:

1. Motor vehicle registration showing the vehicle is registered in your name (applicant, spouse, or licensed dependent living at address – if last names differ, also provide a copy of birth certificate, marriage license, or other official document supporting request), and
2. One of the Following:
 - a. Current utility bill containing the appropriate name and address.
 - b. Rent or lease agreement containing the appropriate name and address.
 - c. Notarized declaration of residency by the owner or manager of a rental property.
 - d. Driver's license with the appropriate name and address.

Applications may be made either through the mail or taken in person to the 1st floor counter at the City Center Building located at 220 E. Huron (diagonally across the street from City Hall). **Fees are \$45.00 per permit, per calendar year. Replacement permits are \$30 when returning previous permit (or pieces including the permit number). Annual Visitor Placards are \$45 each & are household-limited depending on your location; you must be a Participating Household to qualify (purchase at least one annual permit).**

The residential parking permit shall be permanently affixed to the lower, left front windshield (driver's side). It shall be unlawful and a violation of this application agreement for the person to falsely represent him or herself as eligible for a parking permit or to furnish false information in an application to the City Administrator. It shall also be unlawful and a violation:

- (a) For a person holding a valid residential parking permit to use or display the permit on a vehicle other than for which the permit was issued.
- (b) To use, or allow to be used, a residential parking permit for commuter parking.
- (c) For a person to copy, produce or otherwise create a facsimile or counterfeit residential parking permit in order to evade parking regulations applicable in a residential parking permit area.

VIOLATION FOR ANY OF THE REASONS OUTLINED ABOVE WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF PERMIT

REVOCAION OF PERMIT: Representatives of the City Administrator are authorized to revoke the residential parking permit of any person found to be in violation of the agreement and upon written notification thereof, the person shall surrender such permit to the representative.
