



COMPOSTABLES!




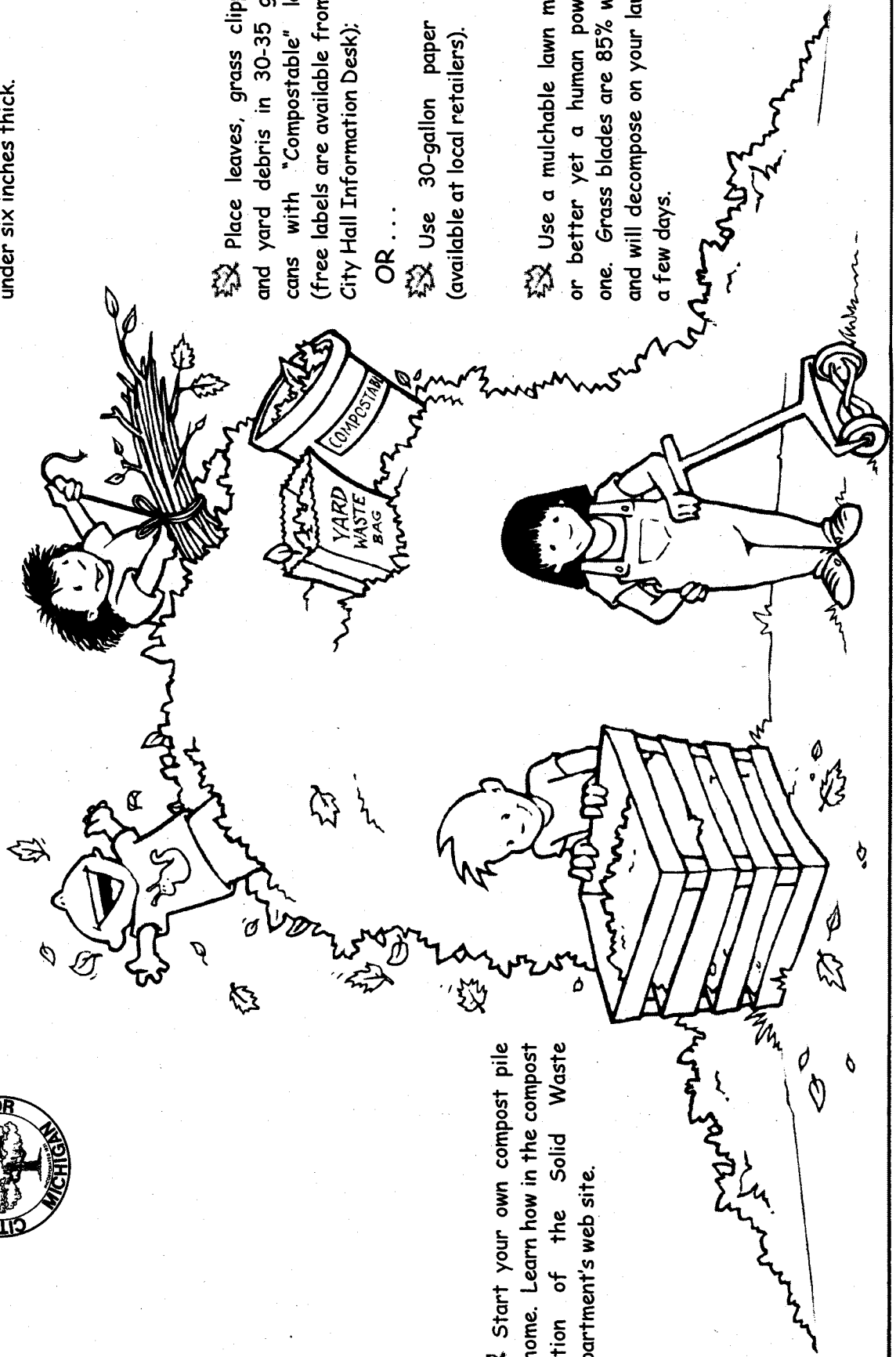
 Cut brush and branches to 3-4' lengths and tie into bundles up to 18" around. Tree limbs must be under six inches thick.


 Place leaves, grass clippings and yard debris in 30-35 gallon cans with "Compostable" labels (free labels are available from the City Hall Information Desk);

OR...

 Use 30-gallon paper bags (available at local retailers).

 Use a mulchable lawn mower or better yet a human powered one. Grass blades are 85% water and will decompose on your lawn in a few days.
