Welcome to the Eleventh Annual Mayor's Green Fair

Welcome to Green Fair. It is time to celebrate another year of successful sustainable city programs that provide services in cleaner, greener, and more cost-effective ways. We are developing a Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Program to bring funds for energy efficiency and renewable energy to commercial property owners in the city. We hope to expand this program to residences when state law provides that opportunity. This effort will create jobs, keep more money in the local economy, and bring huge environmental benefits. The Downtown Development Authority has a successful program with local businesses to help fund energy audits and efficiency measures that make it cheaper to do business downtown. We are still a great town for recycling. Four new, energy-efficient hydraulic-hybrid recycling trucks are on the streets using 15 percent less fuel. The trucks help support the expanded single-stream recycling program that started last year along with a recycling incentive program through RecycleBank. Recycling is up almost 20 percent due to these efforts.

We continue to receive recognition for the ongoing efforts of citizens, staff, and City Council. Recent awards include being named a 2011 Finalist for the All-America City Award, 2011 Gold-level Walk Friendly Community, 2010 Governmental Award of Excellences in Urban Forestry, and Winner of the International Energy Globe Award for Sustainability at the 2010 World Environment Day (Rwanda). Today we enjoy a community that is built upon the foresight and dedication of residents before us that will continue to pay dividends for future generations. We are a better city because of the ideas brought forward by the public, volunteer service on commissions, and feedback in public forums. Thank-you for all of your efforts, such as visiting and supporting our parks; volunteering with Natural Area Preservation; walking, biking, or bussing to work; and buying locally. Each of these steps add up to the unique and special community of Ann Arbor. Enjoy the Green Fair!

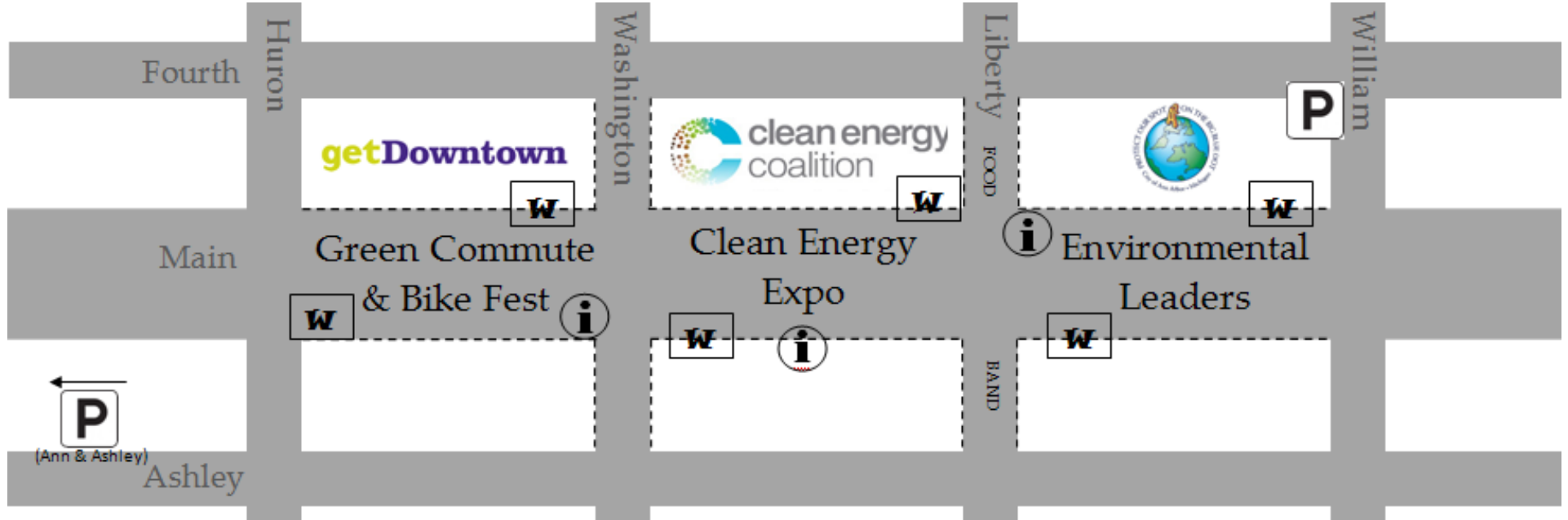
