

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10:162 OF CHAPTER 127 (BICYCLISTS) OF TITLE X OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR.

The City of Ann Arbor Ordains:

Section 1. That Section 10:162 of Chapter 127 of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor be amended to read as follows:

10:162. Registration procedure.

- (1) All registered bicycles must have a serial number permanently marked on the frame. Such marking may be applied at the time of registration.
- (2) Application for registration shall be made on forms furnished by the city clerk.

(3)

On the form, applicants for bicycle registration shall:

- (a) Provide the applicant's name and address;
- (b) State whether the bicycle is new or used;
- (c) State the make, type and color of the bicycle, and the serial number of the frame;
- (d) If the bicycle is used state how the bicycle was acquired, such as by a transfer of ownership or purchase from a used bicycle dealer. If it was acquired by a transfer of ownership, the former registration number, if previously registered in the City of Ann Arbor, must be included on the application form.
- (e) Provide information as required by subsection (5) that the bicycle has not been identified as a stolen bicycle;
- (f) Provide any other information required by the City Clerk that is reasonably needed for registration purposes; and,
- (g) Pay the city a registration fee, as determined by city council resolution.

(4) All registrations issued on or after March 1, 2010, shall expire on April 30 of the fifth year following the issuance of the registration. All registrations that were issued before March 1, 2010, shall expire on April 30, 2014, of which legal publication of this ordinance shall constitute notice.

(5) A bicycle is not eligible for registration if the bicycle is identified it as stolen based on the description of the bicycle on the application and police department records of stolen bicycles. The determination that the bicycle does not match a bicycle in the police department's available records of stolen bicycles shall be made by the

police department or, if the police department provides the city clerk with the information, by the city clerk. If a stolen bicycle is recovered by or returned to its owner, the owner shall notify the police department, who shall remove the bicycle from the records of stolen bicycles.

(6) If the bicycle is eligible for registration, a registration card will be issued to the owner, which will contain the name and address of the owner, a description of the bicycle and the registration number and a registration tab will be provided to the new owner, which will contain the words "City of Ann Arbor" and the number of the registration.

(7) Before operating the bicycle, the owner shall firmly attach the registration tab to the rear of the bicycle seat tube in a manner that does not obscure the serial number.

(8) A record of all bicycle registrations providing identification by owner's name, bicycle serial number and registration number shall be maintained by the city clerk.

(9) Registrations may be renewed for one additional 5-year period at no additional cost to the applicant provided the owner of the bicycle applies to the City Clerk for renewal no later than 90 days following expiration of the existing registration. A new registration and payment of current fee is required for any registration that is more than 90 days past expiration.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect on March 1, 2010.
