## SIGNIFICANT CRIMINAL EVENTS FOR May 5, 2009

**BREAKING & ENTERING**                      **2500 Blk Jackson Ave.**                      **3-16-09 (Days)**  
Officers were dispatched to a Breaking & Entering where checks were stolen. After one suspect's arrest on 5-3-09 a second suspect was named and made a confession.  
**SUSPECTS ARRESTED**

**UNARMED ROBBERY**                      **Stimson & Industrial**                      **4-25-09 (Days)**  
The victim, after shopping at Kroger's, put his purchases in a knapsack. As the victim walked toward CVS he was approached by two subjects that demanded his money. The victim refused and was struck in the face. After the victim pulled a knife the suspects fled. The victim observed one of the suspects a couple of days later and called the police who took the suspect into custody.  
**SUSPECT ARRESTED**

**LARCENY FROM MOTOR VEHICLE**    **1200 Astor Ave.**                      **4-30-09 (Midnights)**  
Officers were dispatched to an attempt larceny from a motor vehicle. Upon arrival officers were informed that two subjects had stolen a backpack from a vehicle. The suspects fled and were apprehended.

Officers were dispatched to an armed robbery of a citizen. The suspect had run up on the victim and demanded money. The victim advised she didn't have any and the suspect began to choke her and stated he was going to shoot her. He began to drag the victim and then ran off. The suspect was later located and apprehended.
