Most GPS units have the capability to have the owner's home address programmed into the unit. If the home address is indeed programmed in this manner and the GPS is stolen, the thief now has the person's address. The thief could conceivably drive to that address knowing the homeowner was not there and break in before the owner returned. Choosing not to store your home address on your GPS unit is another way to ensure your safety.
