The public is encouraged to attend a meeting to address the Zoning Ordinance Reorganization (ZORO). This project is being established to clarify and reorganize the zoning ordinance and other development-related ordinances.

The City's land use and development ordinances and regulations are scattered among 11 different chapters of the City Code. Each chapter was prepared and adopted independently and results today in a sometimes confusing, hard to follow format with inadvertent repetition and slight inconsistencies.

The goal of the ZORO Project is to clarify and reorganize them into comprehensive, clear, usable, enforceable and legally defensible, and adaptable chapters. This public meeting will introduce the ZORO Project, provide background information and allow an opportunity for questions and comments.
