Several Polling-place Changes Take Effect with Tuesday, Aug. 3 State Primary Election

ANN ARBOR, Mich., July 26, 2010 — Tuesday, Aug. 3, 2010, is the State Primary Election to elect candidates for City of Ann Arbor mayor and City Council members in all five wards. Other county, State and federal offices will also appear on this ballot.

City of Ann Arbor polling locations will be in operation from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., including several new polling places. All polling places previously located in University of Michigan dormitories have been moved to other on-campus locations due to university housing safety standards. In addition, Skyline High School (2552 N. Maple Road) has become a polling place, replacing the Mack School location. New voter registration cards were mailed to effected voters.

Voters at Tappan Middle School (3-3) and Thurston Elementary (2-9) should be aware of parking lot construction at these sites on Election Day. Voters at Tappan Middle School can enter the polling place using the west entrance off of Brockman. The parking lot at Thurston Elementary School will not be available to voters on Election Day. Parking will be available on Prairie Street and a marked path will direct voters from the street to the main entrance.

Below are important voter tips and ward and precinct polling location information.

Voter Tips

- Voters should not wear buttons, t-shirts, or any visible apparel or signage that supports a candidate into the polling places on Election Day as this is considered campaigning, which is not allowed within 100 feet of a polling location. **Voters who visibly display a candidate's picture or name will be asked to remove** the material while standing in line or voting.

- Don't forget to bring your **photo ID** to vote. Voters who do not have acceptable photo ID will be required to sign an affidavit in order to vote.
- **Peak voting hours** are from 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Voters who want to avoid long lines are encouraged to vote during midday hours.
- **Polling place hours** are 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. If you are standing in line by 8 p.m. then you are eligible to vote.
- The City Clerk's Office is still accepting applications for **absentee ballots**. The office is open to the public for absentee ballot requests on Saturday, July 31, 2010 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. In-person requests for absentee ballots will be accepted at the City Clerk's Office, 2nd floor of City Hall, until Monday, Aug. 2 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- **Ann Arbor Public Schools are closed on Election Day.** Polling places located within schools are open. Signs will be posted at all polling locations to assist voters.
- The Aug. 3 election is a primary. Voters can only vote for candidates in one party — republican or democrat; crossover voting is not permitted.

- **Washtenaw County election results** are televised on Community Television Network's CitiTV Channel 19 beginning at 10 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 3, 2010 — after the polls close — and will continue throughout the night.
