

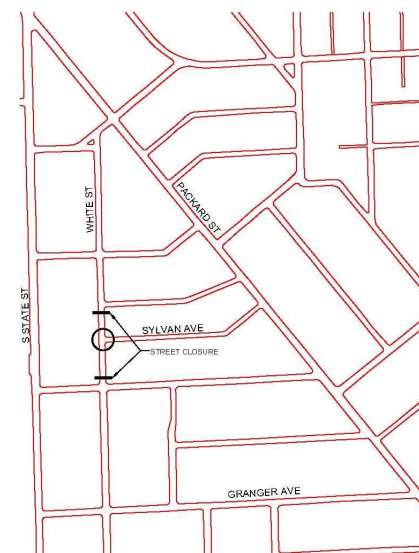
# Sylvan Avenue Ribbon Cutting

Sylvan Avenue (between Packard and White Street) has received a cutting-edge, **environmentally friendly** solution to ease its drainage issues. It's been repaved with a permeable **asphalt** which allows **rainwater** to pass through the pavement into a stone reservoir, where it is filtered, **cleaned** and temporarily stored until it can be absorbed into the ground or gradually enter the storm sewer system. Come **see** for yourself. **Rain or shine!** Parking on adjacent streets is available for guests.
