**Notice of Temporary Traffic Control Plan**  
**PLYMOUTH ROAD WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT**  
**(July 26 – September 30, 2010)**

**Location and Limits of Affected Area:**

Plymouth Road Water Main Replacement project will be completed in two phases. Phase I of the construction is located west of Barton Drive and east of Broadway St. Phase II of the project is located east of Barton Dr and west of Broadway St.

**Description of Work:**

The construction for the Plymouth Road Water Main Replacement project includes installation of approximately 392 feet of 12" Water Main in Phase I and 1077 feet of 20" Water Main the Phase II of the project.

**Temporary Construction Traffic Control Plan:**

Phase I of the construction is expected to last three (3) weeks, from Monday July 26 through Friday August 13, 2010. The traffic lane reduction starts at the intersection of Jones Drive and extends approximately 1000 feet to the west. For the most part, the two outbound traffic lanes will remain open as before. The two inbound traffic lanes will be reduced to one traffic lane and will be shifted to the south.

Phase II of the construction is expected to last five (5) weeks, from August 16 through September 17, 2010. The traffic lane shifts will start west of Upland Dr. and will extend approximately 2500 feet to the west. Except for a short distance, the two outbound lanes will remain open to the traffic at all times. The two inbound lanes will be reduced to one lane of traffic.

To ensure the construction workers' and the public's safety, please reduce speeds and drive cautiously through the construction zone. We thank you in advance for your patience as this necessary public infrastructure improvement is completed.
