## COURT HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

### **IT IS ORDERED:**

This Administrative Order is issued in accordance with MCR 8.110 (D)(2)(c) and MCR 8.112(B). Effective January 01, 2011, the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court and its employees shall by this order observe the following holidays:

New Year's Day	January 1
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	3 <sup>rd</sup> Monday in January
President's Day	3 <sup>rd</sup> Monday in February
Good Friday (Noon to 5:00 p.m.)	Friday before Easter Sunday
Memorial Day	Last Monday in May
Independence Day	July 4
Labor Day	1 <sup>st</sup> Monday in September
Veterans Day	November 11
Thanksgiving	4 <sup>th</sup> Thursday in November
Day After Thanksgiving	4 <sup>th</sup> Friday in November
Christmas Eve (Noon to 5:00 p.m.)	December 24
Christmas Day	December 25
New Year's Eve (Noon to 5:00 p.m.)	December 31

Employees of the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, and most employees of the City of Ann Arbor (funding unit), work a Monday through Friday schedule. Therefore, the following holiday observance rules apply:

- 1) When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the holiday will be observed on the preceding Friday.
- 2) When a holiday falls on a Sunday, the holiday will be observed on the following Monday.
- 3) When a holiday falls on a Saturday, and the preceding Friday is also a holiday, then the holiday will be observed on the preceding Thursday and Friday.
- 4) When a holiday falls on a Sunday, and the following Monday is also a holiday, then the holiday will be observed on the following Monday and Tuesday.
