
IT IS ORDERED:

The purpose of this order is to designate an off-site place in the City of Ann Arbor where sessions of district court may be held for specific cases.

1. The 15th Judicial District Court will hold sessions of court for its Street Outreach Court (Homeless Court) program on a bimonthly basis throughout the year between the hours of 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. at Ann Arbor City Hall, 301 E. Huron St., Ann Arbor, Michigan, in Basement Conference Room A.
2. The cases heard in court will be predetermined.
3. Defendants may decline to participate and may request that their cases be heard in the courthouse proper at another time.
4. The off-site docket will be open to the public.
5. The plan for these off-site sessions takes into account factors regarding:
 - a. security;
 - b. approved recording of proceedings;
 - c. adequate sound systems;
 - d. notification to parties/witnesses/public;
 - e. site decorum, flags, furniture, and audience participation;
 - f. transportation of court files and records;
 - g. post-hearing transactions such as payments and clearances; and,
 - h. docket coverage for hearings scheduled at the courthouse proper.

This local administrative order will expire December 31, 2019.
