The City of Ann Arbor has directed funding to help Washtenaw County households who have housing choice vouchers and are justice-impacted to avoid eviction and improve housing stability and self-sufficiency. **The Rising Hope for Housing is a pilot program running between July 1, 2023 until June 30, 2024.**

Requirements to participate:

- Must be a Washtenaw County resident.
- Already have a housing choice voucher OR been approved to receive a housing choice voucher.
- Someone living in the household who is or has been justice-impacted.

Some program services include:

- Trauma-informed Case Management
- Peer Support / Mentorship
- Move-in Assistance
- Security Deposit
- Rent Arrears
- Utility Shut-offs

Service providers making household referrals to the program must have applicant complete an application with a signed Release of Information (see QR code above). Referrals should be sent to A Brighter Way. Supportive services will be provided by A Brighter Way, Catholic Social Services Offender Success, Shelter Association of Washtenaw County, and/or SOS Community Services.
