
## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This survey was conducted by the Ann Arbor Housing Commission in the spring of 2020. The primary purpose of the survey was to find out whether low-income families with children would live in housing in downtown Ann Arbor and if so, what features were important to them.

The surveys were completed by Ann Arbor Housing Commission residents and community members attending events at Bryant Community Center. A total of 104 participants answered the survey.



### Would you live downtown if your housing costs were the same as they are now?







# Which type of housing do you currently live in?




What is your household's annual income?






