"Three generations of my family lived in and around the state of Uttar Pradesh in northern India over a period of 75 years. It all seemed so exotic to someone growing up on the South side of Chicago. Thus, when I have been presented with opportunities to visit India it has been with great joy and a sense of returning home. Hindi and Urdu words and phrases were liberally sprinkled into family gatherings as we shared tea prepared in ritualist ways and old pictures from India were passed around and discussed at great length. As a photographer, I believe that all faces are interesting, if not beautiful, and I have tried to capture that in a part of the world that holds a primal and mystical meaning in my life."
