Safety Update COVID-19 Report

The Washtenaw County Health Department recently released a COVID-19 Mortality Report on the first three years of the pandemic (March 1, 2020 - Feb 25, 2023). The report acknowledges the significant loss of life locally, but also recognizes that the death rate across Michigan was higher compared to Washtenaw County. Per the Health Department, "In Washtenaw County, Health Department staff, health care workers, community partners, and volunteers worked countless hours to respond to the pandemic— and community members listened to guidance to protect themselves and others. There were ongoing challenges and significant resource limitations, but our collective actions mattered and reduced deaths and disease in our community". The Ann Arbor Greenbelt's 20th anniversary also marks the program's first-ever affordable farmland purchasing opportunity via its buy-protect-sell initiative. Farmers are invited to submit a proposal to buy protected farmland that is being sold at a reduced price thanks to this new initiative.

Under the new buy-protect-sell initiative, the first opportunity is a farm located on Nollar Road in Northfield Township. The 54-acre farm is being sold in two parts: the 20-acre North Parcel and the 34-acre South Parcel. Applicants can submit proposals to purchase either parcel, or both.
