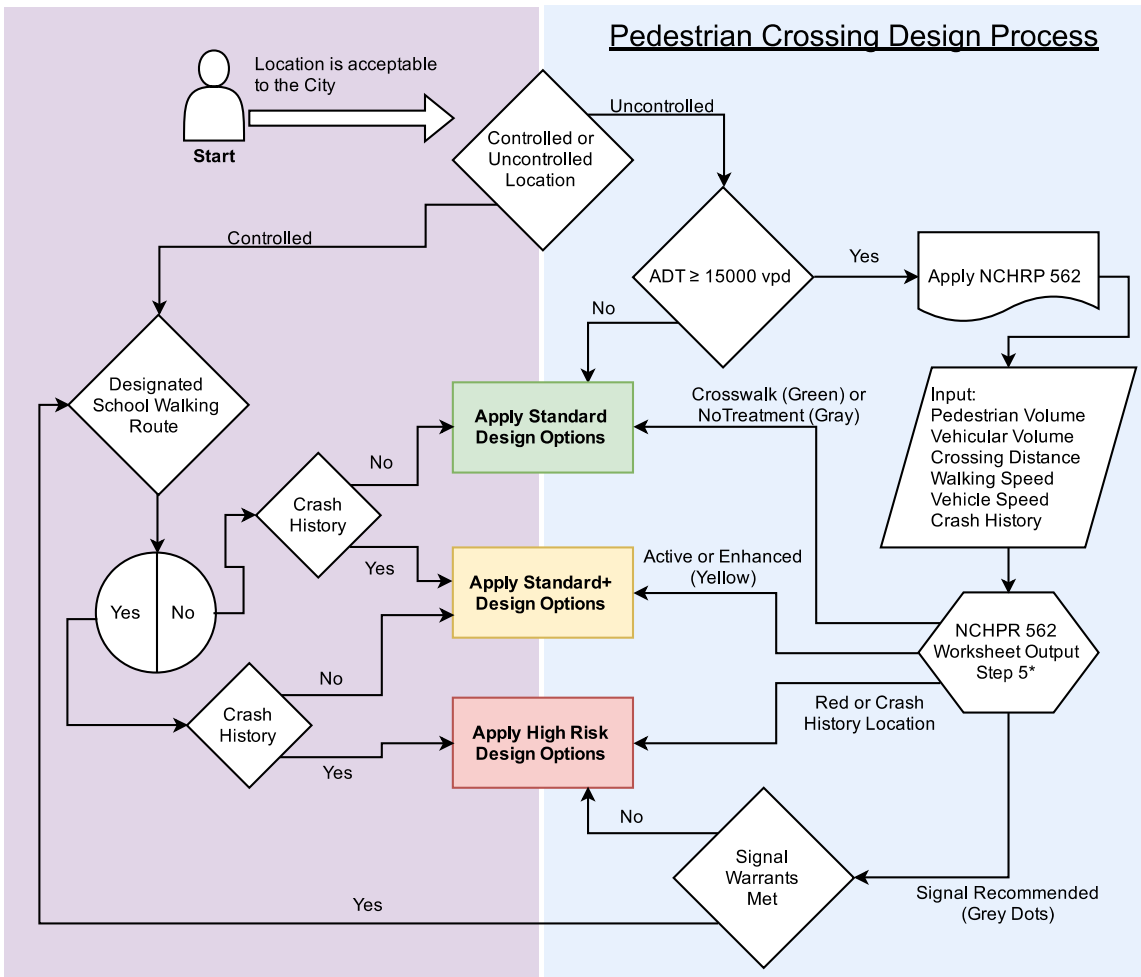


Pedestrian Crossing Design Process



*Uncontrolled locations that are on designated school walk routes are increased by one treatment level.

Crash History Defined:

The term "crash history" can mean different things to different people and in different contexts.

For the purposes of the Crosswalk Design Guide, crash history will be defined as:

- The existence of local transportation system-wide crash patterns or a nationally recognized crash pattern for a type of crossing, e.g. uncontrolled crossings with multi-lane approaches, or
- The existence of a site specific crash pattern that may contribute to pedestrian-vehicle interaction problems. Crashes of this nature may or may not involve pedestrians.
