Meeting Notes

Questions or comments from attendees were submitted both by computer and phone audio (live) which were paraphrased or through the Zoom Q&A feature. Answers and responses from staff during the meeting are marked with an '**a**'. Clarifications or responses provided after the meeting are denoted as "*Post-Meeting Notes*."

Overview

An electronic meeting through Zoom was held to provide a brief overview of the Traffic Calming process, to discuss the Preliminary Plan specific to Fulmer Street (Miller-Foss) as well as modifications to the Preliminary Plan. Refer to the Traffic Calming Guidebook available at <u>a2gov.org/TrafficCalming</u> for additional information on the Traffic Calming process. Considering the Preliminary Plan shared at Meeting #2, community feedback, street conditions, utility locations, and engineering practices, staff will develop a Final Plan for step 5: Final Polling.

Discussion

- **1.** Raised Devices: Is this project able to request raised devices taller than the standard three inches (3")?
 - **a.** *(Post-Meeting Notes)* No. The Traffic Calming Program is currently restricted to following guidance dictated by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).
- **2.** Raised Crosswalks: What is the procedure if the one-year follow up survey shows no improvement/worsening of traffic conditions?
 - **a.** *(Post-Meeting Notes)* The Traffic Calming team will work with the community to discuss options. However, this scenario has never happened to date.
- **3.** No Thru Traffic signing: Who enforces violations of the No Thru Traffic sign posted at the Stadium Boulevard intersection?
 - a. (Post-Meeting Notes) Community Standards (a division of the Ann Arbor Police Department) handles enforcement requests. Please note, they will only conduct enforcement if they are requested. A report can be filed <u>online</u> or through the A2 Fix It app. You may also reach them at 734-794-6942. The AAPD prefers residents to contact them directly so they can get additional information if necessary.
- 4. Additional Devices: Will a third device be possible in this project area?
 - **a.** *(Post-Meeting Notes)* No. The project area is limited to a maximum of two devices to maintain safe spacing in accordance with FHWA guidelines.
