Dean bequeathed \$2 million to the City of Ann Arbor *“to be held in trust in perpetuity, to repair, maintain and plant trees on city property.”* The trust is managed by the Elizabeth Dean Fund Committee which accepts proposals for special tree planting and maintenance projects to enhance Ann Arbor’s urban and community forest.
