PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This 225 unit development located next to a Whole Foods market, is a five-story sustainable building featuring generously sized studio, one- and two-bedroom residences including a first-floor enclosed parking garage with two secure entrances, bike storage and EV charging stations. The access to walkable retail amenities at Cranbrook Village and Woodland Plaza, proximity to transit, and many major employers allows residents to live and work in Ann Arbor. Amenity spaces include a two-story club house, a rooftop terrace, and 20,000 square feet of second floor open courtyards housing a modern gym, business center, kitchen, grilling areas, pet wash, coffee and snack bar. The proposed project will require a re-zoning from O-Office to R4E-Residential.









You are invited to attend a Resident Participation Meeting for a project near you. At this meeting you will have the opportunity to learn about the proposed project, ask questions, and submit comments. The developer will utilize your input to inform the advancement of design solutions.
