The Ann Arbor Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session, Sunday, March 4, 2018 at 6pm. The session will be conducted in Council Chambers – Larcom City Hall, second floor, located at 301 E. Huron St. Ann Arbor, MI 48104.
