Effective July 1st 2017

15th District Court ordered fingerprints will take place on
Thursdays from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm
on the 3rd Floor of the Justice Center (301 E. Huron St.)

The following documents are required:

- Copy of 15th District Court Order For Fingerprints
- Copy of 15th District Court Felony/Misdemeanor Complaint
- Valid form of identification (driver's license, state ID card, student ID, or passport)
- This process includes obtaining descriptive data, palm print and photographic images
