SUBJECT: Student Move In/Out Fall 2019

COLLECTION AREA

Days: Thursday, August 15 through Wednesday, September 4, 2019

Hours: 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily

No deliveries accepted overnight; and subject to illegal dumping fines.
Site will be actively monitored 24 hours.

Location: Tappan Street between East University and Oakland Avenue

Access: From East University; Tappan Street at Hill Street open for local traffic only

Materials accepted:

Bagged trash; mattresses; discarded furniture; curbside recycling

Reusable items accepted:

Clothing; non-perishable food; toiletries; furniture, working electric appliances

Not accepted:

Freon Containing Appliances; Refrigerators; Televisions; Electronics;
Construction Debris: wood, wallboard, flooring, tile, wires, spools, pallets, and any material of a similar nature; Carpet; Liquids of any kind; Paint; Yard Waste; Food Waste; Compost; Biohazardous or Hazardous Waste; Ovens and Dishwashers; Bathtubs and Hot Tubs; Material that needs to be broken down to place into the Dumpsters; Material that takes more than two people to lift into the Dumpsters

Curbside Refuse and Recycling: All refuse and recycling must fit inside city trash or recycling carts with the lid closed. Material sitting on top of, alongside or in front of carts will not be picked up. Set cart out no earlier than 24 hours before collection day and remove carts from the curb no later than noon the day after collection. Any violation of this policy will be subject to a Community Standards violation with a minimum fine of \$100 plus court costs.

Cardboard Recycling and Extra Recycling Service: Contact Recycle Ann Arbor at 734.662.6288 or info@recycleannarbor.org to arrange an extra recycling service or special cardboard pickup. Recycling carts need to be brought to the curb for service. Cardboard boxes must be flattened and folded, or cut into sections that will fit into the bed of a pickup truck (5'x5' or smaller). Pickups will generally be scheduled the following business day.

City Serviced Trash Dumpsters: Apartment sites in the **Central Campus Area** that have Dumpster Service provided by the City, may request an extra tip, at no additional cost, for Monday, August 19th and/or 26th, Friday 16th, 23rd and/or 30th. Apartment sites must pre-schedule with Customer Service 734.794.6000 by Thursday the 15th, 22nd and/or 29th. During move in/out, additional extra tips of dumpsters other than on August 16th, 19th, 23rd, 26th, and 30th will be available in the Central Campus Area at a cost of \$89.00 per tip.

Dumpsters will not be serviced if they are blocked by vehicles or excess/overflowing trash: All trash must fit within the dumpster with the lid closed. Blocked dumpsters will be serviced on the site's next scheduled day. If the dumpster owner requests the City to return to service the dumpster, the scheduled tip rate of \$89.00 will be assessed.

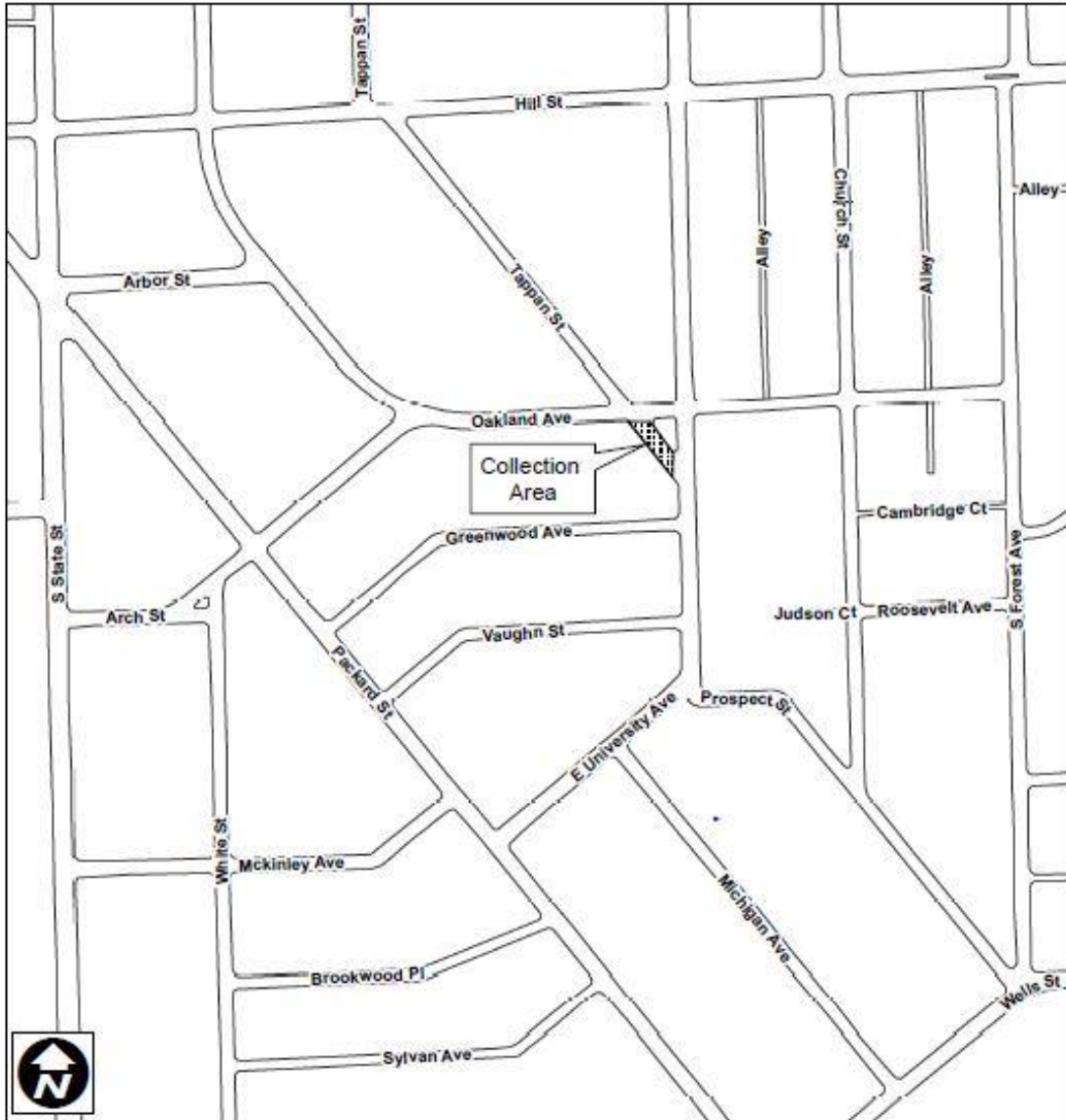
