## I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the RFP. Respondents are directed to take note in its review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

- Question 1: Given that the Thanksgiving holiday is the last full week of November, could the proposal due date be extended out to sometime in December
- Answer 1: Proposals will continue to be due as originally requested and provided herein.
- Question 2: Does the City have a preliminary schedule they can share for when the solar and battery storage installations would be occurring and for how long?
- Answer 2: Due to ongoing contracting, and uncertain supply chains, the project timeline is still variable. However, construction is expected to begin in the late spring of 2023, with the sites being completed in 3 phases. Phase 1 will include the sites at the Ann Arbor Municipal Airport, including the Steere Farm Pumps, and the Water Treatment Plant. Phase 2 will be the installation at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, and Phase 3 will be the installation at the Wheeler Service Center.
