City Curbside Compost Bins

If your property has <u>8 units or less</u>, you may be eligible for city curbside service. Request a cart by contacting city customer service at 734.794.6320 or by emailing customerservice@a2gov.org.

Commercial Compost Service

Subscribe to a commercial compost collection service that offers pickup directly from your buildings. This option is recommended only for properties that are ineligible for city curbside bins.

On-Site / Backyard Composting

Set up and manage your own composting system on the property. Compost tumblers and 3-bin systems work best for homes and small communities with outdoor space and engaged residents. For those with limited outdoor space, worm composting is a great alternative.
