## I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the RFP. Respondents are directed to take note in its review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

- Question 1: Do you envision any stakeholder engagement in this project and if so, who are those key stakeholders?
- Answer 1: We envision significant internal engagement with the Office of Sustainability and Innovations, the attorneys office, the Sustainable Energy Utility, and potentially a few other internal stakeholders. We do not, however, envision public engagement under this scope of work.
- Question 2: You mentioned the gas rate case, how does that impact the timeline for this project?
- Answer 2: No gas rate case has been filed yet so it's impossible to know how this case, and its contents, will impact the scope of the work under RFP 25-50 at this time. However, should there be something in the filed case that warrants a reconsideration of timelines or the sequencing of activities, we will negotiate that with the selected vendor.

- Question 3: On the reference side, some of our work has been confidential, how should we handle that?
- Answer 3: We recommend providing public references and, if relevant, providing anonymous examples if they speak to your ability to do work materially similar to what we are seeking in RFP 25-50.
