I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the ITB. Bidders are directed to take note in their review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

- Question 1: I am reaching out in regards to bid ITB #4775 Streetlight Luminaires. Can you please confirm if there would be an opportunity to submit lighting fixtures for review and pre-approval? Or will proposed fixtures be evaluated and approved after bid opening?
- Answer 1: We have been pleased with the current streetlight fixtures and want to stay with the product that was specified at this time in an effort to standardize. The City may be interested in other available options after the closure of ITB# 4775 so feel free to reach out to the technical contact provided in the ITB Document on those options.
- Question 2: Is it okay if we send 2 bids together in a sealed envelope? We'd like to send in a bid for Decorative Post-Top Streetlights as well as for Streetlight Luminaries.
- Answer 2: That would be fine but make sure each response to ITB# 4774 Decorative Post-Top Streetlights and ITB# 4775 – Streetlight Luminaires are sealed in their own envelope within the outside mailing envelope.
- Question 3: Just touching base with a quick question on the 50 luminaires specified in this bid: I can see that you have requested a gray housing color; would the city consider black, dark bronze or white?
- Answer 3: No, we are trying to keep the streetlights uniform throughout the city.
