Bank Robbery (26-7317)

On 2/13/26 at approximately 4:35pm, officers responded to the PNC Bank at 2992 S. Main Street for a report of a bank robbery. Preliminary investigation revealed a woman entered the bank and passed a note to the teller demanding money. The note indicated she had an explosive device and also had a firearm. No explosive device or firearm were seen during the incident. The woman was given an undisclosed amount of cash.

The woman had already fled the area when officers arrived. The bank was evacuated and a K9 sweep of the bank was done out of precaution. No explosive device was found.

Investigators identified the suspect as 26-year-old Christina Ikerd of Wayne. She was taken into custody without incident on 2/14/26. On 2/15/26, Ikerd was arraigned on one count of bank robbery at 14A-1 District Court. Her bond was set at \$75,000 cash.

This arrest reflects the strong teamwork between our patrol officers and detectives, who worked quickly to identify and apprehend the suspect. Great work by everyone involved.
