Investigation Update – Shooting Suspect in Custody

Kevin Chenevare-Lowery, 26, of Ypsilanti Twp. has been charged in connection with a December 7, 2025, incident that occurred on Weldon Blvd. During the incident, it is alleged that Chenevare-Lowery was attempting to break into a homeowner's vehicle when he was confronted by the homeowner. During the encounter, Chenevare-Lowery fired multiple shots, striking and killing the homeowner's dog. The homeowner was not injured.

Chenevare-Lowery is charged with six felonies, including: Assault with Intent to Murder, Killing/Torturing Animals – Second Degree, Carrying Concealed Weapon, Firearms Possession by Prohibited Person, Ammunition Possession by Prohibited Person, and Felony Firearm. He was arraigned on May 28, 2026, at 14A-1 District Court. He was given a \$500,000 cash/surety bond.

Statement from Chief Andre C. Anderson

“Our detectives worked tirelessly on this investigation for months and were able to identify the suspect and make an arrest. This case is another example of our department's continued commitment to serving our community, pursuing justice, and never giving up on an investigation.”

12/7/25 Original Release:

At approximately 4 a.m., officers responded to the 1800 block of Weldon after a homeowner confronted a suspect attempting to break into a vehicle. During the incident, the family dog, a yellow Labrador named Miley, exited the home and was shot and killed by the suspect, who then fired additional rounds while fleeing. No one else was injured.

The suspect, described as an adult male dressed in all black with a face covering, was not located despite an extensive search, and investigators believe he may have been picked up by a driver. We are reviewing home surveillance video.
