Section 3 Workers:

- Public housing residents
- Low and very low-income persons who live in the area where a HUD-assisted project for housing or community development is located.
- YouthBuild participants

Section 3 Businesses:

- At least 51% or more owned by Section 3 residents
- 75% or more labor hours are performed by low or very low-income persons over a 3month period
- 51% or more owned by current residents of public housing or Section 8-assisted housing
