## Materials List:

- Knitting needles, any size (for beginners, use 8 to 9 US, bamboo or wooden are less slippery)
- Large Skein of Yarn for knitting a scarf, any thickness (for beginners, a medium weight – "worsted" – yarn is great)
- Crochet hook, any size (for beginners, use size H / 8, metal is better for crochet)
- Smaller Skein of Yarn for crocheting a hat, medium to heavy thickness
- 3" wooden hoop (for cross stitch project)
- Cross stitch fabric (Aida Fabric 11 or 14 count) any color you'd like (white, offwhite, brown)
- 6" wooden hoop (for embroidery project)
- 10" square of embroidery fabric (muslin, linen, or thicker cotton solid color, white/off white)
- Embroidery Needles
- Embroidery Floss (Embroidery floss will be used for cross stitch, embroidery, and plushie hand sewing projects specific shade is not important as long as all colors chosen to look good together)
  - Yellow Embroidery Floss
  - o Brown Embroidery Floss
  - o Dark Green Embroidery Floss
  - o Light Green Embroidery Floss
  - o Dark Pink/Rose Embroidery Floss
  - Light Pink Embroidery Floss
- Hand Sewing Needles
- White thread
- Straight pins
- (2) sheets of felt (colors should be matching bring green if you want to make a cactus, bring brown if you want to make a squirrel, bring other bright colors to make a cat)
- 1/3 of a yard of cotton fabric, or "fat quarter" any color or design (for making a zipper pouch)
- 1/3 of a yard of solid color cotton fabric, or "fat quarter" (for lining of zipper pouch)
- Zipper to match colorful fabric anywhere from 4" to 12" in length
