

Materials List:

- Knitting needles, any size (for beginners, use 8 to 9 US, bamboo or wooden are less slippery)
- Large Skein of Yarn for knitting a scarf, any thickness (for beginners, a medium weight – “worsted” – yarn is great)
- Crochet hook, any size (for beginners, use size H / 8, metal is better for crochet)
- Smaller Skein of Yarn for crocheting a hat, medium to heavy thickness
- 3” wooden hoop (for cross stitch project)
- Cross stitch fabric (Aida Fabric 11 or 14 count) – any color you’d like (white, off-white, brown)
- 6” wooden hoop (for embroidery project)
- 10” square of embroidery fabric (muslin, linen, or thicker cotton – solid color, white/off white)
- Embroidery Needles
- Embroidery Floss (Embroidery floss will be used for cross stitch, embroidery, and plushie hand sewing projects – specific shade is not important as long as all colors chosen to look good together)
 - Yellow Embroidery Floss
 - Brown Embroidery Floss
 - Dark Green Embroidery Floss
 - Light Green Embroidery Floss
 - Dark Pink/Rose Embroidery Floss
 - Light Pink Embroidery Floss
- Hand Sewing Needles
- White thread
- Straight pins
- (2) sheets of felt (colors should be matching – bring green if you want to make a cactus, bring brown if you want to make a squirrel, bring other bright colors to make a cat)
- 1/3 of a yard of cotton fabric, or “fat quarter” – any color or design (for making a zipper pouch)
- 1/3 of a yard of solid color cotton fabric, or “fat quarter” (for lining of zipper pouch)
- Zipper to match colorful fabric – anywhere from 4” to 12” in length
