I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the RFP. Respondents are directed to take note in its review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

- Question 1: Under the Professional Qualifications section, we are asked to provide "resumes and qualifications" for all proposed project personnel. Would it be enough to state a person's name, title, job description, length of employment at our organization and that each of our employees is background checked? Or do you need actual resumes?
- Answer 1: Resumes should be provided for a complete bid. Resumes are only needed for key personnel, not for all employees who will help to execute the project.
- Question 2: What quantities of electronics have been collected at events in the past?
- Answer 2: Our past events have required one to two box trucks with around 6,000 pounds of materials collected per event.
