

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "MELODALE" a subdivision of part of the southwest quarter, section 30, Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows:

Commencing at the east quarter post of section 25, Scio Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence S. 00° 07' - 30" E. along the Township line between Scio and Ann Arbor Townships 756.17 feet to an iron pipe monument in the south line of "BOULEVARD HEIGHTS"; thence S. 89° - 58' - 30" E. along said south line 299.7 feet FOR A PLACE OF BEGINNING; thence continuing S. 89° - 58' - 30" E. 245.08 feet to the westerly line of Stadium Boulevard; thence S. 24° - 49' - 30" E. along said westerly line 761.81 foot to the center line of Liberty Street; thence S. 75° - 48' W. along said center line 581.07 feet; thence N. 00° 07' - 30" W. 834.15 feet to the place of beginning.
