

## Ready for your rebate? Follow these easy steps.

### Step #1: Confirm the details

- » You are a resident of, or a registered business in, the City of Ann Arbor
- » You have an Income Verification Number: [osi.a2gov.org/rebates](https://osi.a2gov.org/rebates) (optional)
- » You reserved funding and have a Rebate Reservation Number: [osi.a2gov.org/rebates](https://osi.a2gov.org/rebates) (optional)
- » Review sections and individual measures for eligibility requirements

### Step #2: Attach a copy of your receipts and invoices

- » Provide Income Verification Number and/or Rebate Reservation Number if applicable
- » Provide copies of all dealer invoices and Michigan vehicle registration
- » Your receipt or invoice must clearly indicate the vehicle type, make/manufacture, model, price, and date of purchase

- » Complete documentation must be received within 90 days of purchase of vehicle. Rebate funding is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis until available funds are exhausted

### Electric Vehicle Rebate Reservation (Optional)

Applicants interested in reserving program funds should visit [osi.a2gov.org/rebates](https://osi.a2gov.org/rebates) to complete a separate reservation application. If approved, you will receive a reservation number and the program will hold your rebate dollars for 90 days while your vehicle is purchased. After project completion submit your reservation number below and final invoice to the program for payment. For reserved projects, completed rebate application must be received within 90 days of reservation approval.

A reservation is not required to apply for a rebate. Applications without a reservation will be processed on a first come, first served basis while funds are available.

## Section 2: EV Rebate Program Information and Requirements:

- Applicants must be residents of the City of Ann Arbor or businesses physically located and operating within the City of Ann Arbor.
- Business applicants must register the vehicle in the business's name and at its Ann Arbor business address. Businesses located outside Ann Arbor are not eligible, even if they conduct business within the city.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- There is a limit of one rebate, regardless of category, per household or business.
- Eligible vehicles must be battery electric vehicles (BEVs) powered solely by electricity and charged by plugging into external charging equipment. Hybrid electric vehicles (HEVs) and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEVs) are not eligible. Vehicles may be new or used and must have four wheels, a battery capacity of at least 10 kWh, and a maximum speed of at least 55 mph. Leased vehicles must have an initial lease term of at least thirty-six (36) months to qualify for a rebate.
- Eligible vehicles must be purchased or leased from a licensed motor vehicle dealer on or after May 1, 2026, and registered to an eligible Ann Arbor household or business.
- Rebates may not exceed 90% of the purchase price of the eligible vehicle.
- As a condition of receiving a rebate, applicants agree to complete brief program surveys annually for the first two (2) years following rebate payment. Survey responses will be used by the City of Ann Arbor to evaluate program participation, vehicle usage, and program impacts.

- » Incomplete applications cannot be processed for payment.
- » Applications must be received within 90 days of purchase and include invoices of purchased electric vehicle and required documentation including the vehicle's Michigan Registration.

# A<sup>2</sup>ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program Terms and Conditions

## Application

This application, along with any required additional documentation, must be truthful, complete, and accurately filled out. Applicants should retain a copy of this application and any accompanying documentation submitted to the A<sup>2</sup>ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program. The City of Ann Arbor and its contractors will not be responsible for lost documentation pertaining to this application request. Details of this program, including rebate levels, are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. All applications and required documentation must be received within 90 days of the purchase or lease of the eligible vehicle.

## Limited Funds

Funds for rebates are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Submission of an application does not guarantee rebate funding. Rebates will only be issued while program funds remain available. The City of Ann Arbor reserves the right to not pay a rebate if funds are not available at the time of application approval, or if the application is not complete and accurate, including all required additional information and documentation, or if the application is not submitted within the required time frame. The rebate amount may not exceed the pre-tax purchase price of the eligible vehicle.

## Eligibility

This offer is valid only for residents of the City of Ann Arbor and businesses physically located in the City of Ann Arbor. Limit one rebate per household or business. Applicant must be 18 years or older to be eligible for rebate.

## Vehicle Ownership and Use Requirements

As a condition of receiving a rebate under the A<sup>2</sup>ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program, the rebate recipient must retain ownership of the vehicle for a minimum of thirty-six (36) consecutive months from the vehicle purchase or lease date and may not sell, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the vehicle during that period. Rebate recipients who lease a vehicle must maintain the lease for a minimum initial term of thirty-six (36) months and may not terminate, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the vehicle during that period. The rebate recipient must not make, or allow to be made, any modifications to the vehicle's emissions control systems, hardware, or software calibrations. The rebate recipient further agrees that any emissions reductions associated with the rebated vehicle shall not be used to generate, create, claim, sell, transfer, or market environmental attributes, emissions reduction credits, carbon credits, offsets, compliance extensions, or any other regulatory or market-based emissions benefit.

## Approval and Verification

Prior to any payment of rebates, the City of Ann Arbor reserves the right to verify sales transactions and ownership requirements.

## Proof of Purchase

A dealership invoice or receipt for the electric vehicle must accompany each rebate application. The receipt/invoice must indicate the vehicle make, model, price, and the date of purchase. All vehicles must be purchased from a dealer. A dealer is a person licensed to sell motor vehicles in a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, any other territory or possession of the United States, an Indian tribal government, or any Alaska Native Corporation.

## **Payment**

Unless otherwise stated, if the cost of the vehicle is less than the standard rebate amount, the rebate payment will be limited to 90% of the pre-tax cost of the eligible vehicle. Once a completed application and all required additional documentation is submitted, a rebate payment is usually processed within 6 to 8 weeks. Rebate payments are made by check. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing on the application.

## **Tax Liability**

The City of Ann Arbor will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the recipient of a rebate under the A<sup>2</sup>ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program as a result of the payment of the rebate. Applicants should contact their tax advisor for more information.

## **No Endorsement**

The City of Ann Arbor does not endorse any manufacturer, vehicle, dealer, product, or claim in promoting this program.

## **Information Release**

Applicants agree that the City of Ann Arbor may include their name, address, electric vehicle for which they received rebates, and resulting emissions reductions, and such information may be included in reports or other documentation submitted to regulatory bodies. This information will be treated as confidential and will only be reported in the aggregate.

## **Release/Indemnification**

Payment of rebates under the A2ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program and/or evaluation of applications for rebates does not make the City of Ann Arbor or any of its affiliates, employees, or agents responsible for any vehicle purchased through the program. Applicant fully releases and agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Ann Arbor and its affiliates, employees, and agents from any claims in connection with the application, the rebates, and the purchase, ownership, registration, operation, or use of a vehicle participating in the A2ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program.

## **Ownership and Registration**

Applicant represents that they are the purchaser or legal owner of the vehicle for which a rebate is being requested and that the vehicle is, or will be, registered in accordance with the requirements of the A2ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program. Applicant further represents that all information provided in support of the rebate application is true and accurate.

## **Applicant's Certification**

Applicant certifies that they have purchased the vehicle identified in this application, that they are the legal owner of the vehicle, and that the vehicle meets all eligibility requirements of the A2ZERO Electric Vehicle Rebate Program.
