




DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "Van Dusen Subdivision", a Subdivision of Part of the East 2 of the east 3 of Section 31, Town 2 South, Range 6 East in the City of Ann Arbor, Michigan, is described as follows:

Commencing at the east 1 post of Section 31, Town 2 South, Range 6 East, City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan, and run-ning thence north 0-13'-30" west along the east line of said Section 1,75 feet for a PLACE OF BEGINNING: thence south 88 -43 -15 west along the north line of Stadium Boulevard as now laid out and used 959.20 feet; thence north 0 -44'-45" west 1564.74 feet to the center line of Pauline Boulevard as now laid out and used; thence north 88 -40'-30" east along said center line of Pauline Boulevard 533.15 feet; thence south 0°-44'-45" east 216.5 feet; thence north 88°-40'-30" east 95.00 feet; thence north 0°-44'-45" west 216.5 feet to said cetter line of Pauline B oulevard; thence north 88°-40'-30" east 345.34 feet along said center line of Pauline Boulevard to the intersection with east line of said Section; thence south 0°-13'-30" east along the east line of said Section 230.48 feet; thence south 89°-52'-30" west 141.0 feet; thence south 5°-03'-00" east 100.37 feet; thence north 89°-52'-30" east 132.56 feet to the east line of said Section; thence south 0°-13'-30" east along the east line of said Section 1235.55 feet to the place of beginning.
