I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the ITB. Bidders are directed to take note in their review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

Question 1: What would be the minimum delivery volume for the SHMP?

Answer 1: We do not have a minimum delivery volume, but over the past 3 years our orders have ranged from 21,000-52,500 lbs.

Question 2: What is the address of the plant where the product is being delivered?

Answer 2: 919 Sunset Rd, Ann Arbor, MI 48103

Question 3: The SHMP market is extremely volatile right now. Knowing when the water plant might take the truckload of material will be beneficial when it comes to pricing.

Answer 3: We typically order once or twice per year and avoid winter orders. The first order would likely be in fall or possibly spring.
