On 1/16/26 at approximately 4 p.m., officers responded to Haisley Elementary School in response to serious and violent threats to harm people with a firearm. These threats came as school was being dismissed.

The Ann Arbor Police Department conducted a search of the 18-year-old suspect's residence where no firearms were found. AAPD also worked with Community Mental Health, which developed an immediate plan to get the person coordinated resources. He is currently receiving treatment at a medical facility.

On 1/17/26, the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office authorized the following charges: one count of making terroristic threats (a felony with a maximum 20-year sentence), and one count of making schools threats (a misdemeanor with a maximum 1-year sentence).

AAPD and Ann Arbor Public Schools have a plan to ensure the school's safety in place.

Investigators determined the 18-year-old was the sole person responsible for this incident.
