Page 9	Remove: "The City intends to award one service contract at a value not – to – exceed value of \$60,000." Replace with: "The City intends to award one service contract at a not-to-exceed value of \$25,000 for a one (1) year period."
Page 11	Remove: "These personnel must be a licensed physician, licensed psychologist or licensed psychiatrist."
