I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the RFP. Respondents are directed to take note in its review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

Question 1: What is the current vending cost for products being sold in cold beverage

Answer 1: Products being sold currently are priced between \$1.00-\$2.00.

Question 2: May a vendor provide a presentation along with delivering its RFP?

Answer 2: Presentations will only be granted if the City decides to move forward with a formal vendor interview process.

Question 3: What is the City's current commission rate for cold beverage sales?

Answer 3: The City receives from its current Contractor a 22% NET revenue commission rate minus deposits with cold beverage vending sales.

Question 4: What is the current incentive fee that the City receives?

Answer 4: The City currently receives a sponsorship payment in the amount of \$10,000 per year to be set aside to be used for the Parks and Recreation Scholarship Program.

Additionally, the Contractor sponsors a minimum of 4 special events per year and

donates 50 cases of product annually to be used for City sponsored activities at the discretion of the City.

Question 5: What amount of rebate does the City currently received?

Answer 5: The city receives a \$0.96 per case rebate on actual cases distributed through the

Contractor.
