The AAPD is actively investigating two groping incidents that occurred on 4/17/25 in the downtown area.

At approximately 11:20pm, a woman was walking in the area of Fifth and William when an unknown male approached her from behind and groped her. The victim continued walking when approximately one minute later, the same suspect approached her again and groped her a second time. When the victim confronted him, he ran southbound on Fifth Ave.

At approximately 11:45pm, a woman was walking up to the front porch of her residence in the 1000 block of Greenwood Ave. when an unknown male approached her from behind and groped her. The suspect then ran northbound on E. University after the victim yelled at him.

Both victims described the suspect (surveillance video attached) as a black male, 20 to 25 years old, 5'8" to 6'0", with a skinny build and wearing a light-colored jean jacket and beanie style hat.
