Changes in the Bid Documents which are outlined below are referenced to a page or drawing in which they appear conspicuously. The Bidder is to take note in its review of the documents and include these changes as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

## **Questions and Answers**

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the ITB.

- Q. Can Wing Curb be used as Bituminous Curb on Newport? This being placed with our paver while paving the mainline?
- A. It should be a Vertical Type Bituminous Template and not a "winged curb."
- Q. What is happening with Larchmont, Pomona and Wells? I do not find Plan sheets for these that has Qty breakdown? They are listed as Traffic calming streets, but I thought Adam had said that we would be performing resurfacing on them.
- A. Only traffic calming items. These streets are not being resurfaced.
- Q. Do you have a typical detail for Raised Intersections, i.e. length & striping particularly?
- A. The striping quantities will be double what is shown on the Traffic Calming Pavement Marking Detail (Sheet 2 of the Plans).
